Her grandmother on her mother's side was Kahiri and her grandmother on her father's side was Go'ovino of the Gusirajé clan. Jessy-Rose paints designs shown to her by her grandfather, a Gusirajé clanman, such as rorono hanö'e, Gusirajé clan design of the roron'e plant; sabu ahe, spots of the wood-boring grub; and ninubu hanö'e, design of the brown-coloured orchid fibre used to weave armlets and waist belts. She is a passionate and dedicated painter and takes great pride in her art. She has one child.
