Her mother was Kitty Kantilla's sister. Marie Carmel was 'grown up' by her mother's (in Tiwi culture, aunties have similar kinship relationships to the birth mother).

She came to live in Milikapiti as a young girl, where she married and raised a family. She began painting at Jilamara Arts and Crafts in 2001, developing her own unique style.

Marie has been exhibition in Jilamara group shows since 2001. Her artwork has been acquired by the Laverty Collection (Sydney)
