Biography

Marcia's mother was photographed with her two sisters, all in their early 20's the day they saw 'whitefellas' for the first time. They were living a traditional nomadic life in the heart of Spinifex Country when the British atomic testing of the 50's and 60's destroyed life as they knew it and they were moved into the mission at Cundeelee. Marcia was born in Kalgoorlie as babies were not birthed at the mission, but at the nearest hospital. Today Marcia spends her time divided between her two homes; Tjuntjuntjara in the Great Victoria Desert and Kalgoorlie some 700 kms to the southwest.
