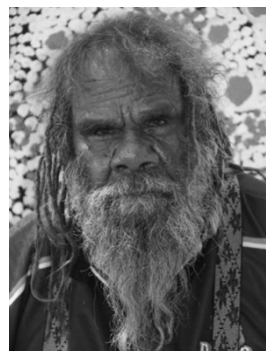

Neville McArthur was born at Tutana a rock hole in the Spinifex Country south of Warburton. He has lived most of his life in Patjarr and Warburton but now resides in Wanam. Neville paints tjukurpa from his homeland in Spinifex Country such as Wilpina (Lake Baker, south-west of Warburton) and Walu Tjukurpa. He couldn't tell any details about Wilpina – it's a strong and sacred Tjukurpa. Neville has had a long career as an artist working with the Spinifex Arts Project, Warburton Art Project, Kayili Artist and since moving to Wanam in 2010, working with Warakurna Artists. He is also recognised for his skilful carving of traditional men's weaponry.
