Veronica Daniels was born in Yuendumu and has spent time both there and in Balgo. Veronica is the daughter of renowned Warlayirti Artists and senior Law woman Sarah (Manaya) Daniels. Veronica sometimes paints her mother's country called Mina Mina and her father's country around Yuendumu. Veronica paints tjurnu (waterholes) and the abundance of mangarri (bush tucker) including Kumpupatja (bush tomato), ngaarlukutu (bush coconut) and Tjirilpatja (bush carrots). Veronica also includes the rainbow serpent in many of her paintings. Veronica has 3 children, 4 grandchildren and a growing number of great-grandchildren.
